## EAST BOISE

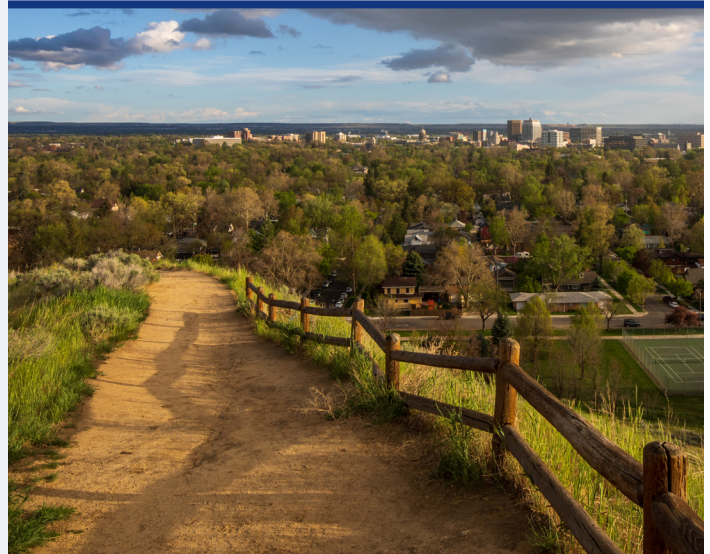
